- The Waverly archery club is a 501C7 nonprofit organization

 - o 3D archery: shooting at foam animals to simulate a hunting scenario
 - Field archery: 3 field archery courses with 14 targets ranging from 20ft to 80yards
 - Target/Olympic archery: Target range up to 60 yards
 - o Broadhead range: Practice range for hunters
- Provide safe environment for club members, youth organizations and the community to practice archery.

Activities:


